

Bursary Application Form

The Condé Nast College Bursary Guidance

There are two bursaries available for the BA (Hons) Fashion Communication, which are available for UK applicants only, and are funded by the Condé Nast Publications Ltd. These are awarded at the discretion of the College Admissions Panel. They are intended to assist talented students who would not otherwise be financially in a position to undertake the course.

The applicants need to demonstrate that their annual income, if they are financially independent, is below £20,000 per annum, or if they are financially dependent, that their parents'/family annual household income is below £50,000 per annum. Students who meet this criteria are invited to indicate their interest in competing for one of the Condé Nast bursaries by completing and signing the designated bursary application form. This will include a confidential Financial Disclosure and should be submitted after students have submitted the standard, online College application form.

Along with all other students, bursary applicants will undertake the College Challenge and interview as part of the normal application process. Before the interview, you must indicate that you have applied for a bursary in order for your application to be considered.

Candidates who have been shortlisted for a bursary will then be invited for a second-round interview with the Admissions panel a few months prior to the start of the course.

Successful students will receive a 100% remission of fees. Prior to the confirmation of the award successful candidates will be required to provide hard copy evidence of earnings/financial status.
